In late 2016 Melbourne Water started work on the M40 water main renewal project.

This involved trenching and installing 1700mm diameter pipes from Arthurton Road to Oakover Road, within the centre-median along St Georges Road. We tunnelled under Miller Street.

This is an important project for Melbourne Water as the existing main was almost 100 years old and was at the end of its service life.

As part of our reinstatement works, we have replanted the palms and trees on the west side of the centre and constructed the new shared path.

To maintain safety while we transfer pedestrians and cyclists onto the new shared path, we will undertake this process in two stages, working north.

See our key steps in the graphics.

At the end of September we plan to transfer pedestrians and cyclists to the new wider, shared path.

This will be completed in sections:

- **Bent Street to Normanby Avenue**
- **Normanby Avenue to Hutton Street**
- **Hutton Street to Miller Street.**

Once our construction work has been completed, we will complete the section from Bent Street to Arthurton Road.

As we will have construction equipment onsite until the reinstatement work has been completed, there will be fencing around our work zones.

Please take extra care as you travel along the new shared path.
