M41 Merri Creek to MCG Water Main Renewal Project

Construction update August 2018

Construction of the M41 Merri Creek to MCG Water Main Renewal Project has commenced on George Street from the intersection of Kerr Street and is now moving progressively towards Condell Street, Fitzroy.

This update provides information about additional works to be undertaken from Charles Street to Webb Street on George Street by City West Water. The works will be commence from **Monday 27 August 2018.**

Additional City West Water works

City West Water and Melbourne Water are working together to upgrade an additional smaller water main also running along George Street, which is owned and operated by your water retailer, City West Water. This water main was installed in 1885 and supplies water directly to you and your neighbour's properties.

The main is reaching the end of its service life after 130 years and needs to be replaced to ensure ongoing reliability of your water supply.

While this additional work will add a small amount of time to the M41 works, it will minimise the overall disruption to you by avoiding the need for City West Water to conduct further water main works in your street in the near future.

What can you expect

- Site establishment with temporary fencing erected to delineate the work zone
- Temporary loss of vehicle access to driveways and off-street car parking on George Street
- Temporary changes to on-street parking and traffic conditions
- Temporary lane and road closures and changes to the speed limits near work areas
- Noise from various construction plant, vehicle and activities such as rock breaking
- Dust and vibration
- Increased construction vehicle movement in local area

Traffic detours

There will be local traffic management and detours in place during working hours. Our traffic controllers will be on duty at each work location to ensure traffic and pedestrians can navigate around our worksite safely during working hours.

Please follow the signage and direction of our traffic controllers and allow extra travel time. We encourage you to familiarise yourself with these temporary traffic changes as there are some temporary traffic directional changes whilst the works are undertaken.

These temporary changes may be in place for a period of up to 4 weeks, weather permitting. The project will reopen up the road as soon as it is safe to do so.

Construction hours

These works will be performed during the day between 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and Saturday between 7am to 1pm.
