# M41 Merri Creek to MCG Water Main Renewal Project

# **Construction update October 2019**

The M41 water main runs from Merri Creek, Northcote to Wellington Parade, East Melbourne and supplies drinking water to over 350,000 residents and businesses. The project to replace the old main is now being finalised, and the new main is online supplying water to Melbourne's inner suburbs.

# **Reinstatement of Falconer Street, Fitzroy North**

This update is to provide further information on the asphalting of Falconer Street. The project will permanently reinstate the road, from kerb to kerb, from **Monday 21 October 2019**.

The permanent reinstatement of the road will occur on Falconer Street from Delbridge Street to Alfred Crescent. The project anticipates reopening Falconer Street to all vehicles by Thursday 24 October 2019.

# Temporary changes to on-street parking, off-street parking and vehicle access to driveways

There will be no on-street parking and no vehicle access available within the work zone while the works are undertaken. This includes temporary loss of vehicle access to driveways and offstreet car parks from Falconer Street.

#### These temporary changes may be in place for a period of up to 5 days, weather permitting.

Please keep in mind that as a result of these temporary road closures, there will be limited onstreet parking available in neighbouring streets for both local residents and businesses.

The project will reopen the road as soon as it is safe to do so.

## **Traffic detours**

There will be local traffic management and detours in place during working hours. Our traffic controllers will be on duty at each work location to ensure traffic and pedestrians can navigate around our worksite safely during working hours. Please follow the signage and direction of our traffic controllers and allow extra travel time.

- Temporary lane and road closures and changes to the speed limits near work areas •
- Noise from various construction plant, vehicle and construction activities •
- Dust and vibration
- Increased construction vehicle movement in local area
